The first red to be born into the Teruzzi&Puthod family, Peperino is an elegant and well-balanced, though at the same time confident, wine, whose name reflects its spicy and characterful taste. Obtained from Sangiovese and Merlot grapes, it presents a pleasant well-blended oaky note with fruity characteristics.

TASTING NOTES

Deep, lustrous ruby red with good depth.

Satisfyingly intense, long-lingering nose, the oak tones melding seamlessly with the fruit.

Appealing yet self-assured, full-bodied palate with assertive, nicely gauged tannins and a lingering after-aroma.
